WAMS staff member, Rhiannon Peoples, assisted in the coordination and supply of personal and protective goods to residents in the Pilliga who were isolated due to flood waters.

Supplies were transported via helicopter which landed on Burren Junction Road as all other areas were inaccessible.



Supplies included Bushmans, Rid, pocket torches, water bottles, stress balls and hand sanitiser and were received on the ground by SES personnel on behalf of the Pilliga community. They were very thankful for the donation and supply of these goods from WAMS.

This small community with minimal access to essential goods and flood isolation will provide some relief to all community members.
