Attention Parents & Carers

Who should be vaccinated?

Everyone aged 6 months and older should get vaccinated against swine flu.



NSW HEALTH

In 2009 babies and pre-schoolers were more likely to be hospitalised from swine flu than any other age group. Swine flu is expected to return in 2010.

Protect your whole family now with the free vaccine.

Vaccination is also very important for:

- Pregnant women
- People who care for young children

Where can I get my family vaccinated?

Most GPs and Aboriginal Medical Services and some community health centres and local council clinics are providing the swine flu vaccine (for more information contact your local public health unit). Call ahead to make sure the practice or centre is vaccinating on the day you wish to visit.

The vaccine is free for everyone.

Your GP may charge a consultation fee.
