**Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists are invited to submit artworks for the ALS 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Poster Competition to celebrate our 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year.**

Aboriginal activists and lawyers established the Aboriginal Legal Service in 1970. It was staffed by volunteers providing free legal advice and representation to Aboriginal people in inner-Sydney.

In 1971, Aboriginal Legal Service received its first Government grant for the salaries of a full time solicitor, a field officer and a secretary.

Aboriginal Legal Service was Australia's first free legal service, setting the model for mainstream community legal aid.

In 2011, Aboriginal Legal Service (NSW/ACT) commemorates 40 years of service to the Aboriginal community.

The ALS 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Poster Competition is a chance for talented Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists in NSW and ACT to be recognised by a local and national audience.

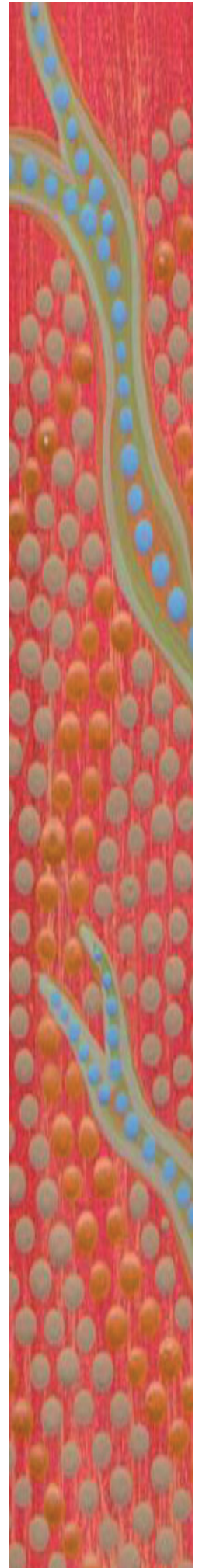

## Terms and Conditions

By completing and submitting the Entry Form, each participating artist agrees to be bound by the following terms and conditions of entry:

- 1 All participating artists must be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent. The artist must be an individual. No group entries will be accepted.
- 2 The artworks are judged by ALS nominated representatives. Chance plays no part in selecting the winner. The decision of the judges will be final and absolute. No correspondence about the decision will be entered into.
- 3 The artist may submit one artwork via email and digital photo, or through the post.
- 4 The artist acknowledges that their artwork may be copied or reproduced for the purposes of judging the competition. If a photo version of the artwork is short listed by the judging panel, the artist will be required to mail in their artwork at their own expense and risk for judges to make a final decision.
- 5 The ALS accepts no responsibility and disclaims all, or any, liability for any loss or damage incurred by any person, whether directly or indirectly, as a result of postage, delivery or handling of original artwork to and from the ALS. The ALS will return entries only if a return address is provided.
- 6 A completed Entry Form signed by each artist must accompany the artwork to indicate agreement to these terms and conditions.
- 7 All participating artists warrant that the artwork submitted is original work, the artwork submitted has not been the recipient of a major prize before and that they have not charged or otherwise encumbered the work nor given any assignment inconsistent with these terms and conditions. Where an artist is under the age of 18, the artist's adult parent/guardian must complete the Entry Form by stating their own name on behalf of the name of the artist to indicate their agreement with these terms and conditions on behalf of the artist.
- 8 An award of \$2,000 will be offered to the winning Entrant.
- 9 By signing a completed Entry Form, submitting an art work and accepting the award offer, the winning artist ('the winner') and all artists: • agrees to permit ALS to publish reproductions of their work for any non commercial purpose, including ALS brochures, ALS information materials, ALS newsletters, promotional posters, and ALS websites for a period of two years from selection; • consents to any of the following types of acts or omissions by the ALS: (a) use of all or part of the art work in accordance with the licence granted above, with or without attribution of authorship to the artist (but the ALS will not falsely attribute authorship of the entry); (b) supplementing the art work with any other material; and (c) use of the art work in a different context to that originally envisaged; • may be requested to physically sign a licence and consent form relating to the art work, prior to the competition being finalised. • agrees that the ALS may publish, on the 2011 40th Anniversary Poster and in any other material in which the art work is used or reproduced, any personal information provided by 'the winner' in connection with their entry including, but not limited to, the winning artist's name, age, community and State/Territory of residence; and • warrants that there is no cultural or religious reason or any other impediment that prevents the winning artwork from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
